Dearly Beloved Brethren and Friends,

We are constantly reminded of the variety of gifts in the body of Christ, here in the work of the Lord in the ministries of MITC. The Lord manifests the variety of HIS operations day after day. No single person can do all things and each person is essential as the body functions with all the God given gifts, talents, and the means of each member individually, as the above scripture teaches. We are grateful as we see this reality happening every day right before our eyes! Praise the Lord for His many gifts and callings through which His Name is made known throughout the World and specifically here in Mexico.

Our **second year students** were used in a very special way during the weeks of the summer. The second year group was divided into teams of two and they went to different villages in the mountains to hold weeklong Vacation Bible Schools', teaching the children the Word of God. This year's program was about the battle of faith, using the theme of **John Bunyan's** work "**The Holy War**" as the illustration for the teaching and the stories of Joshua and the Israelites conquering the land of Canaan. The children learned that without Christ as our Savior we are trapped in our sin and slaves to our desires. They also learned that His Victory on the Cross of Calvary is the liberation, bringing freedom from sin and condemnation for all who by grace believe in HIM. Our students traveled to very remote areas in the **Cuicateco** and **Chinanteco** areas of the state of **Oaxaca** and also to the mountain regions of **Veracruz** among the **Nahuatl Indians** in the **Aculcinapa** area.

It is wonderful to see the Scriptures being planted in the hearts of children. Our students use their God-given gifts and the preparation they received here at the Bible School enabling them to do an amazing work in the lives of these young ones. Through the years we have seen many of these children come to know the Lord and later feel called to the ministry, and then come and prepare for ministry here at MITC. Praise the Lord for using our second year students this summer in more than twenty-four churches.



One of the special places we had a VBS was right here on the MITC campus. Each year we are blessed to receive children from our ever-growing neighborhood, who come and learn from our students. The majority of these kids are from non-church going families, but they are allowed to come and learn because of the witness of the mission to the community, of love and good works. It is a blessing to see the parents entrust their children to our students and staff led by teacher **Alfredo Arce** and learn the Bible Stories. This year, we had a wonderful attendance with over **200 children**. Also helping our students to staff this special week of ministry, was the brethren from **Bible Chapel of Delhi Hills**. Leading this USA part of our VBS team was **Kara Landis**, who for many years has teamed with our students and coordinated the brethren coming down from this church in **Cincinnati, OH**. **Pastor Kevin Landis** blessed us during the week preaching the Word in several services in the churches.



Also manifesting a variety of gifts and means, we had the Mission Team from **Broadmoor Baptist Church**. Centering around **Medical Evangelistic Ministry**, this group led by **Pastor Chuck Pourciau** impacted the **Central Veracruz Region**, holding fourteen clinics at different locations including several in the mountain regions of **Aculcinapa and Ixhuatlan**. The Gospel was shared by our students and staff, while our visiting doctors gave general consultations with medicines to the people in each town. While the doctors used their capacities, others in this group gave out clothing, reading glasses, toys and of course Bibles, all showing the Love of the Lord in a variety of ways.



Many hearts were touched by this loving ministry and two new towns with no Evangelical witness were opened to the ministry of MITC by this means provided by the Lord through our brethren of Broadmoor. In the near future we hope to see churches glorifying Christ in these new locations.



Another means of reaching people with the Gospel is through our **Summer Youth Camp**. Each year, this powerful activity is blessed by the working of the Lord through our students, staff and visitors who help. We are thankful to the Lord for the gifts and ministry of our friend and Evangelist **Bill Britt**, who brought messages this year under the theme “**Salvation is of the Lord!**”. Glorifying God’s work in our salvation throughout the messages and activities of the camp, many of the youth attending were brought to repentance and faith in Christ, and also to obey and serve the Lord with the gifts and capacities that God has already put in their lives. We thank the Lord for using our third year students as leaders and counselors for the youth, coordinated by Teacher **Jimmy Roblero**, our Youth Camp Director.
