To begin this new year, we had the visit of the brethren from **First Baptist Church of Haughton, Louisiana** and **Stonepoint Church of Wills Point, Texas**. This forty person group joined together to serve the Lord among us, bringing both a medical team and a construction team. The medical team went out daily to serve in the villages where there are many health needs, holding five clinics in different locations. In two of these places there is no church, but God opened the doors through the authorities who had visited other places where we had held medical clinics, and now they wanted the help in their own towns. This we see as a great opportunity for sharing the Gospel and as individuals are saved and meet, a church will begin in each place.

Coordinating this work was **Sherri Hagerjhelm, Dr. Bill Bailey, Dr. Jamie Malouf and Dr. Rudy Troup**. The construction team helped us advance tremendously with our new building here on campus called the "VCM-2 Building". This facility will also be used for classrooms, bathrooms, and dining and living areas for our growing schools and activities here on campus. This construction work was headed up by **Mark Hagerjhelm and Dick Patterson**, both ministers from FBC Haughton and Stonepoint respectively. They brought several brick layers and helpers to carry brick and to make mortar, cut rebar and the heavy wire used in all constructions here in this part of Mexico (due to requirements for earthquakes). These brethren greatly advanced this project. Both teams, the medical and the construction, worked very hard every day and were a great example of loving service to the Lord. Our **Christian Music School** made its annual mission trip to the **Chinanteco region of Usila**. There they held a Music Congress, teaching many brethren from that region musical skills and instrumental techniques that will greatly help in the churches.

With several of our most advanced 2nd and 3rd year music students, teachers **Erick, Marco, and Esdras** gave classes in guitar, keyboards, bass guitar, choir, music direction and also had conferences on scripturally based Christ-centered worship. To wrap things up, they had a concert with those they trained during the 3-day activity, playing and singing in an open-air auditorium for all the village to attend. We are thankful for the eagerness in our students and staff to serve the Lord and share the good gifts and blessings God has given us here at MITC. Coordinating all the activities in Usila was **Pastor Marco Deseano**, one of our alumni and former worker here in Cordoba at MITC.

We look forward to what the Lord will do among us and in us this year and pray that we may all seek to serve Him. Thank you for your prayers and loving support. His love has united us in His service and in the Good and New Work He is continuously doing among us through Jesus Christ. Praise His Name!
