Thankful that each of our students has access to a cell phone or some type of device with Facebook capacity to receive our live streamed classes each day. We are having great attendance online (those who are not able to attend the live stream can receive the class later). So the **Full Time Bible School** classes continue daily and on schedule. The same is true of our **Saturday Bible School** classes each weekend, and also of the **Christian Music School** program are all going out to homes in many regions of southern Mexico.



Here from our campus facility we are also transmitting many church services, Bible studies, and Devotionals for brethren here in the region. For this we are greatly indebted to our staff member **Ez (Esdras Barroso)** for getting all our staff “up to speed” technologically, and also making sure we are doing our transmissions in a timely and appropriate way. 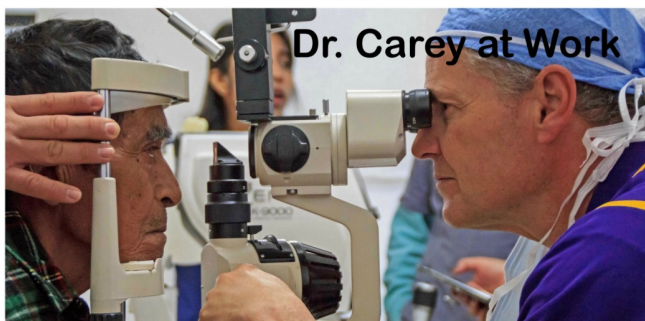

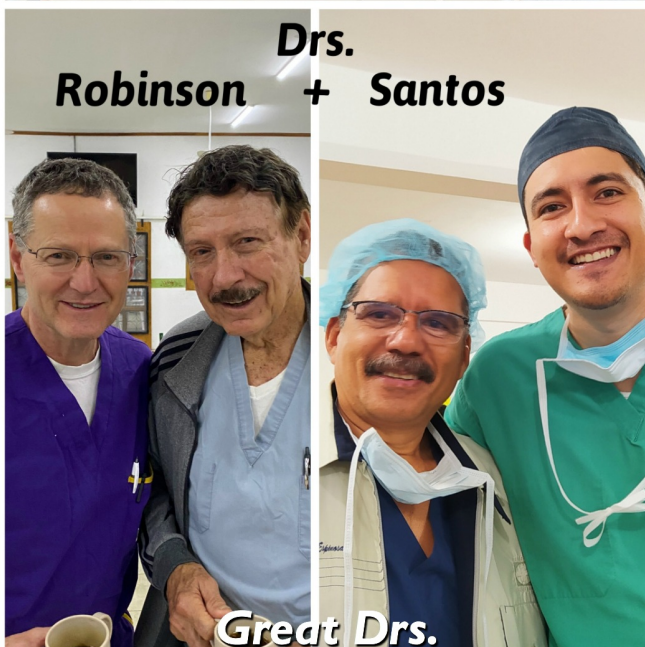
