The last year in our Full Time (live on campus) program is a year in which our students are able to "give back" to the Lord's work by serving in a ministerial capacity in a mission assigned by MITC to help churches in the more remote areas of Mexico. Because of the limitations in the different regions due to COVID-19

we were unable to send last year's 4th year students out to this special time of service. However, in the last few months we were able to bring them back on campus, help them finish out their courses and Biblical studies, and now we have sent them to serve in some of the areas where MITC has been asked for help from our student missionaries. They will be serving for only a half of a year this time, and their postponed graduation from earlier this summer has been moved to December. We share with you the names and places of ministry of these 7 students who are on a real journey of faith depending

upon the Lord and His provision through his people in each of the areas. **Santiago**, among the Nahuatl people in Xoxocotla, **Areli** to the people of Chiapas in Berriozabal, **Alejandro** to the mountain people of Cacique, **Daniela** to the Nahuatl people at Aculcinapa, **German** to the Cuicatecos in the villages of Peña Verde and Teponapa, **Sinai** to Jiquipilas in Chiapas, and **Kevin** to the Cuicatecos in Santa Maria Papalo. Please pray for each of these young servants, for the Lord's protection, and blessing as they proclaim the Good News in Christ.

Also this past month we "sent out" our 2nd and 3rd year students for a 3 week tour in the different mountain regions to hold **Vacation Bible Schools** in the areas that were without COVID restrictions for access and meetings. It was amazing to see how God moved among the churches in these remote areas, using His Word to bless the hearts of both children and their families. The Bible stories were based on the stories from the book of Judges, and showed our need to be freed from our sins by our great Liberator Jesus Christ. 22 different churches were served during this time of service, and many of our students went on to their home churches to continue presenting the program and holding VBS while on their 2 week summer break. We are thankful to the Lord for allowing us to send these teams to the 2 **Chinanteco** regions (upper=Usila, Alianza, lower=Vega del Sol, Arroyo Limon) to the **Nahuatl** region (Xoxocotla, Tecalatzompa), and to the **Mixe** region (Mogoñe, Encinal). Through the years we have seen many of the children in the Vacation Bible Schools become our Bible students as God calls them to His service. We are thankful for our teacher, brother Alfredo Arce and his ministry to the children here at MITC, and throughout the many regions of Mexico.

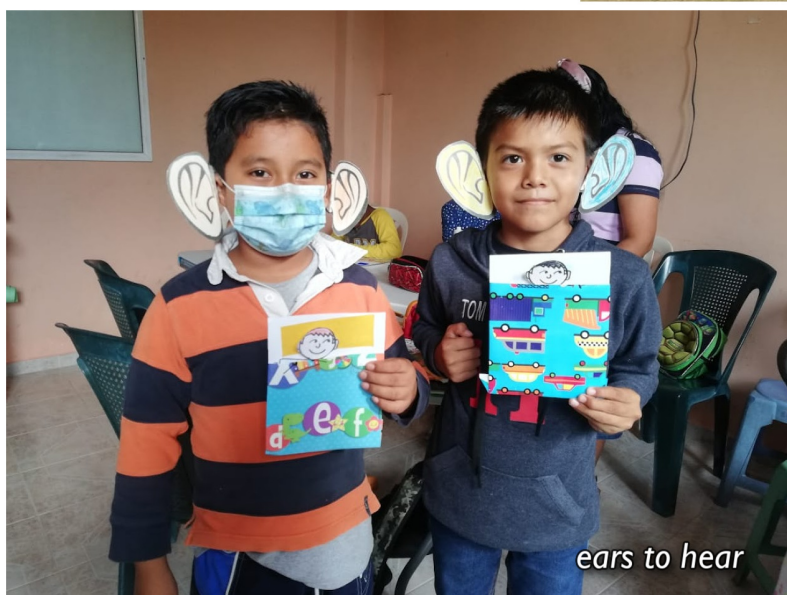
