

All these services were transmitted live online, but we also had a controlled attendance on campus, observing the health recommendations for indoor public gatherings. All went well, the time of learning from the Word of God was encouraging and edifying for all of us, both present and online. Also here from the US to attend the Conference and Graduation, were Mark's wife Paula, Dick Patterson, and Julie Green, and Dr. Dane Logan (MITC Board Member).

Dane Logan has been our mission family dentist for many years, using his dental skills to keep all the faculty and students, with good teeth and healthy mouths. He had not been able to visit us for a long time (because of Covid) so many of us were well overdue for our dental check-ups and treatments. So Dane had a very busy week working on the students, many of whom he had not seen in the clinic before (all the first and second year students), but also taking care of all the dental needs of the staff and families. We are very grateful this dental ministry done in the love of Jesus and for our blessing.






