The annual Women's Conference was a huge blessing once again for the 400+ ladies coming to MITC from many areas of Mexico. This 2-day event led by my wife **Chuy Hall**, and **Sarah Davidson** from Woodcreek church, has been greatly used by the Lord for 21 years and it is a huge impact in the lives and churches of all who come to hear the teaching of the Word of God by our conference speakers. The conference also provides a time for the ladies to share their burdens and to edify each other's faith in the Lord, and also to have special times of worship together. We are thankful for our partnership with Woodcreek Church and their leading ladies, serving our Lord Jesus together for many years.

To receive "sight" is not only a Biblical metaphor of salvation as we come to "see" the Lord Jesus Christ by faith as our Savior, but for many it was a physical reality too during our Eye surgery campaign led once again by **Dr. Tom Robinson**. Hundreds of people with eye problems came to be treated by the team of ophthalmologists from the US and Mexico who joined together to do a great labor of love in the Name of Jesus here at MITC campus. **Drs. Elesban and Shalom Santos**, our national specialists along with Dr. McIntyre, performed cataract surgeries and special consultations on the adult patients.



Drs. Black, and Williams headed up the pediatric surgeries fixing strabismus (crossed eyes) in the children. Over 90 patients received eye surgeries. All of this free of any monetary charge and with the purpose of sharing the love and grace of God. Our Bible students help staff the 2 clinics (for adults and children) during the 3 days of surgery, and they are also able to share the Gospel with all the patients and their families as they come for this much needed help. All the children require general anesthesia for their procedures and we are blessed to have a great and loving team led by Jordan Sherman-Scott and with the supervision of **Dr. David Powell** a veteran of many years of surgical mission trips here to Mexico. This year we were blessed to celebrate also 40 years of pediatric surgeries by **Dr. Brad Black**, who faithfully has taken care of thousands of children here in Mexico with eye problems.

As the psalmist said, "God is good and His mercies endureth forever". Thank you for your loving support for MITC through your prayers and offerings. By them we are able to continue with the many different aspects of the ministry, and continue advancing the Gospel and Name of Jesus here in Mexico.
