The Lord opened people's hearts and even new places to receive the Gospel through this special ministry of love.

We were blessed to celebrate 40 years of partnership with the Medical Team ministry of **Broadmoor Baptist Church**! We praise God for His faithfulness in our lives, and for using our beloved brethren **Drs. Larry Williams and Tom Harrison** who have led and coordinated this special joint ministry (MITC-BBC) through all these years. A group of more than 40 participants also came this year for this special missions week. The group divided into two teams led by Dr. Rozeman and Dr. Carrier respectively. We were able to serve, visit and share the Gospel through medical attention, with children activities and evangelism groups in 9 different villages treating approximately 1,500 patients. We give glory to God for these great opportunities to share the Gospel and His love.

This year we had our "on campus" VBS with the theme of "David's Kingdom", a program which was produced and taught in our yearly VBS Workshop we had two months earlier. Brother Alfredo Arce was the director and his staff our second and third year students and he was joined by the team from Bible Chapel of Delhi Hills, with pastor **Kevin Landis and his daughter Kara** leading their group. We had approximately 140 kids from the surrounding area of MITC each day, and most of them do not attend church, so it was a great opportunity to witness and share the gospel with them and we believe that we will see the fruit in their lives in the years to come.

During this week we also had the visit of a work group led by pastor Nathaniel Pringle and **Dr. Dane Logan** from Truth Community Church. This group did construction and maintenance work, and Dr. Dane worked long hours in the dental clinic helping all the students and staff with their dental health.
