Lalo serves as an MITC student missionary assigned to the La Cumbre church, and serves in the mission of Dos Rios. There

he teaches Bible studies, and shares the Gospel. This past month he had a tremendous opportunity to share on a much larger scale thanks to the visiting missionary **Dental Team** from Louisiana. As the dentists restored, extracted,



and cleaned teeth, those waiting to be seen wanted to know the reason that these people had come from the US to help them with their dental health, all free of any monetary charge. That is where Lalo explained that it was all because of the Love of the Lord Jesus Christ that the work was being done, and that was why the dentists and helpers were in their town. The dentists

The clinic was a huge impact upon this town that greatly needs the Gospel. The dental team also served up in the mountain region among the Nahuatl people where again their service was a huge blessing and helped to share the Gospel and love of Jesus in word and deed. We are thankful to the Lord for providing this group to help in our ministry here in Mexico.

The youth group from **Lakes Church** from Florida, came and joined with us for a week of service and fellowship. The youth partnered during the week with our full time students in their daily chores to help with the upkeep of the of our campus and facilities, The group also helped with new construction and repairs. During the afternoons they also joined with our students to visit churches and orphanages and the mountain villages, to share the Gospel and do ministry among the children. There were also several of the church staff members here helping **Luis Ruiz** the team leader (youth pastor), with the groups' activities and also teaching and preaching. Many good friendships were made among the students from the US and Mexico, and there was an overall encouragement to serve the Lord taking advantage of the young age and the strength that goes along with it. We hope many of the youth visiting will also be called by the Lord to full time ministry and will be used for the glory of the Lord. One of the moments everyone enjoyed greatly during the week was a shared **Cuban Sandwich meal** that Pastor Luis and his team fixed for everyone. We thank the Lord for his many blessings during this time.

One of the biggest opportunities for sharing the Gospel has been our Eye Surgery Campaign that has been going on since 1978. This effort is led and coordinated by **Dr. Tom Robinson** a MITC board member and ophthalmologist from Alexandria, La. Each trip hundreds of people are treated and operated to help their eyesight. Cataract surgeries, and strabismus surgeries for children, are all performed here on campus during a 3 day campaign during which the whole mission campus and Bible School staff and students, become a huge clinic to receive the patients and their relatives who accompany them. Dr. Robinson is joined by several doctors from the US and from Mexico to perform the surgeries free of charge to those in need of help from all over southern Mexico. We have teams of our students helping in the operating rooms, waiting rooms, all ready to share a word of the Love of Christ and the Gospel message. We are thankful for the many helping hands and hearts that make this outreach possible. Our prayer is that all who come will come to know and believe in the Lord Jesus as their eternal Refuge.
