Teaching the Word from 1 John, and from 1 Timothy, our brother brought challenging and encouraging messages for all mission family but also in a special way to our **20 Bible School graduates** from the Full Time, and Saturday programs. As our graduates finished their time of training (4 years) under our staff and mission, they now will begin their lives of service as pastors and church workers among the churches and missions where the

Lord is leading them to serve. Graduation is truly a wonderful time for the MITC family, as it represents the culmination of the purpose of the ministry of MITC, which is to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and train/prepare individuals called by the Lord to take this message throughout Mexico and beyond. It was a also a special blessing to see the **MITC United Choir** singing once again at this special event, exalting our great God in a majestic way. We thank the Lord for this time of graduation and his blessings upon our students and ministry.

As we finish 2023 we thank the Lord for His provision for MITC, and for each of you who have supported us through your prayers and offerings. Here is a recount of some of the things God has done among us, to God be the glory in and for all things!

1. Biblical training for 165 students called by the Lord to serve. 95 students are in our four year Bible Programs, and 70 in our new Post-Grad Theological Seminary (a 3 year program completely online). 41 students presently live on campus in the Full Time program, receiving room and board in addition to their studies). 54 students are in the Saturday Seminary coming once a week for their classes.
2. Christian Musical Training for 40 students in our 3 year program, and 40 children in the Kids Music program.

In total 245 students are blessed through the MITC ministry, free of any financial charge, as all the ministries of MITC are “by grace and for grace”. This is essential as many of our students come from regions of southern Mexico with very limited or subsistence economies. Many students are from the Nahuatl, Chinanteco, Mixe, Cuicateco, and Tlapaneco people groups. Pray that the Lord will continue to provide for all that is His will for us here in Mexico.

3. We have held 4 weeks of General Medicine clinics giving medicines and consults to patients in remote areas, in which all the patients attending heard the Gospel through our students, staff, and visiting medical missionaries. Also we have had a week of ophthalmology surgery and clinic, operating on cataracts, strabismus and other eye ailments, again with the purpose of sharing the gospel with all the patients and accompanying family members. We also had 3 weeks of dental ministry, with this same goal, hundreds received help in these clinics.
4. We held 6 major on-campus teaching events to help pastors and church workers from many areas of southern Mexico: there were 5 Bible Conferences, and 1 VBS Workshop, all approx. of 1 week duration.
5. In addition to these activities we received 13 other mission teams from churches from the US, who helped with campus projects, and children and youth outreach ministries throughout the immediate region.

Please join us in prayer that the Lord will continue to use us as a channel of blessing for the people of Mexico and in particular to help advance the Cause of Christ in this part of the world. Pray that the Lord will give us the necessary means to accomplish all that is His will using our 17 staff and their families that work here at MITC in these many aspects of the ministry.
