On that day those who are deaf will hear words of a book, And out of their gloom and darkness the eyes of those who are blind will see. Isa 29:18

*As Jesus went on from there, two men who were blind followed Him, crying out, "Have mercy on us, Son of David!" 28 And after He entered the house, the men who were blind came up to Him, and Jesus *said to them, "Do you believe that I am able to do this?" They *said to Him, "Yes, Lord." 29 Then He touched their eyes, saying, "It shall be done for you according to your faith." 30 And their eyes were opened. Mat. 9:27-30*

The Lord Jesus is the One who miraculously gives sight to the blind. He is the almighty Lord, Messiah, the promised Son of David. He also is the giver of spiritual sight, the ability to see God, see His kingdom, and gives eternal life (as Jesus told Nicodemus in John 3), to all who believe in Him. We do not have Jesus' miraculous power to heal the blind, however He gives us gifts for us to help others, to share his love, and to bring hope and the Message of life in Him. So we were greatly blessed to see the gifts the Lord has given to our eye surgeons and their co-workers, helping many recover that most needed faculty: sight! The eye surgery team led by Dr. Tom Robinson, once again came to serve the people of Mexico here at our MITC campus. This surgical ministry that started back in 1977 with **Dr. Robinson** and his wife **Daphne**, has continued until now, thanks to God's grace and provision, and by using the willing hands and hearts of all those on this team. This time we had 2 separate specialty clinics going at the same time, one to do surgeries on children, to correct their strabismus (crossed eyes), and another one for adults, to do surgeries on their cataracts. Over 300 consults and 120 surgeries were performed during the 3 day

campaign, on people with great need, and who could not get this help outside of this campaign. Dr. Robinson was joined by **Dr. Brad Black** our chief pediatric eye surgeon, who is also a veteran of many trips to serve here with us in Mexico, and by **Dr. Elesban Santos** our national head of the Cataract surgery clinic, along with a number of other ophthalmologists from the US and Mexico, who joined together to help this great number of patients. All of the pediatric surgeries required general anesthesia so we are thankful for our anesthesia team
