We were greatly blessed during our Bible Conference for the MITC mission family and Village Leaders this past month, as teacher/missionary **Dr. A. J. Gibson** brought us a four day course on New Testament Theology titled "Fulfilled Prophecies." It was a beautiful time of learning going from Genesis to Revelation, seeing the unity of the Bible and the Plan of God's redemption prophesied through the ages. This prophesy was fulfilled in time with the coming of God's Son, Jesus Christ and in His New Testament people, The Church. We are very thankful to the Lord for the ministry of A.J., who God used to give us a deeper understanding of God's Work and Word, all to the glory of God! It was also a special time of fellowship with the brethren from the **Chinanteco, Cuicateco and Mixe** regions who came to learn from the Scriptures with us and then go back to the mountain regions to continue teaching and leading the churches under their care. We pray that the Lord will continue to confirm the Word received in our hearts and that it will bear much fruit in the years to come.





We thank the Lord for many opportunities to share the Gospel while sharing His love during the Eye Surgery Campaign with Drs. Tom and Carey Robinson. Many surgeries were done for some of the most needy people of the region and also for many brethren from the more remote village areas who came in for this unique time of help on the MITC campus. The Bible School campus transforms into a huge "eye clinic" for the four days of surgery. Our students and staff help in the waiting areas, pre-op, post-op, dining area and children's ward.



They make hundreds of visitors and patients feel at home and at the same time, hear of the Love of God in Jesus Christ. The Robinsons have been coming for almost forty-five years to serve the Lord here in Mexico, helping with the eye health of thousands of patients. There are many testimonies of God's work in healing not only the ophthalmic problems, but also healing and renewing hearts through the Hope found only in Christ. This trip there were cataract surgeries on adults and also strabismus surgeries on children with crossed eyes (done by Dr. Susan Azar). The results are always amazing and moving as blindness is cured or prevented in many of the patients. This was also a "family affair", as Dr. Tom and his wife Daphne were helped by Dr. Carey, John and Jennifer Robinson. As they all worked together, we were able to see a family moved by the love of Christ to serve "on missions" all because of Jesus. This was a beautiful testimony to the glory of God! Our national Director of Surgery, Dr. Elesban Santos, was also here with his nephew Dr. Shalom, both extraordinary surgeons who work faithfully and tirelessly with the Robinsons each time we have this surgery program here at MITC. Praise the Lord for the time of ministry and the gifts and skills He has given to our visiting doctors.



As the work continues here at the mission compound where the Bible Schools are located, we had USA teams visiting us during this time of the year. This past month we had churches travel from **Florida** and **Louisiana**. The first group to come was the team from the **Church At The Mall** from **Lakeland, FL**. This group was led by missions pastor **Alex Davis**.





Alex was accompanied by several of the pastors and staff members from the church, as well a large group of adults who came to serve the Lord among us. The pastors preached in our chapel services on campus and also in five other churches and mountain mission villages throughout the week. The interaction between these brethren and the students and staff was also, a huge blessing, specifically by encouraging several of our newer Bible students (1st year) as they are confirming the call to ministry in their own lives here at MITC. It is great to see how God works among us using the many spiritual gifts and love of our brethren.



Trinity Baptist Church from Shreveport LA also came and ministered among us. Senior Pastor Chris Hough and his family and Worship Pastor Paul Flowers and his family came leading this team. They both preached and led worship here at MITC and also at Gracia Baptist Church at La Cumbre and Ebenezer Baptist here in the Farmer's Torch colony in Cordoba, as well as mountain village ministries among the Nahualt tribe. It was a blessing to receive the teaching of the Word of God through these brethren as God used them to edify our lives. Shannon Flowers (Paul's wife) who was also the trip coordinator, led the children's ministries in all these places and also at one of our ongoing orphanage ministries here in town.



For both of these teams, in addition to their teaching and preaching ministries, we had many works projects here at MITC. These included a new construction project called the VCM-2 Facility (villa, classroom, musical building) which will help us with our growing number of students in the Saturday Bible School (70) and in the Christian Music School Programs (65). Also we continued with our ongoing "church pew project" for mountain village churches, this time making pews for the churches in the Chinanteco villages of Santiago and San Pedro Tlatepuzco.

Several painting and renovation projects for staff homes and living quarters here on campus were also done. The ladies in these groups worked with **Chuy** and several of the staff wives doing sewing projects and things that help with many different needs here on campus. For all these things we are thankful to our brethren from these groups that help by working and providing the materials to do the projects. Please continue to pray for the **Bible Schools** (Full Time, Saturday, and Local Programs), for the **Christian Music School**, for our staff and students and especially for our **4th year Full Time Bible Students** as they serve in their "Year of Practice" in remote village ministries at this time. Also, continue praying for God's grace and provision for all things necessary for doing His Will among us.

Thank you for your faithful love shown in your prayers and support. God is honored by your service in the name of His Son Jesus. May the Lord bless you and continue to use us all for His honor and Glory.
