Starting Classes

The core purpose of the Mexican Indian Training Center is to prepare individuals who are called by God to teach the Gospel of Christ according to the Bible. The **Full-Time** (on-campus) **Bible School** is a four-year program that intensively teaches the **Word of God** and how to teach, preach, and instruct others. It is a very practical program where the students have many opportunities to teach and preach, work with children and serve in churches in the region and also in the remote areas in the mountains among the different Indian tribes. Having the young men and women living here on campus, there is much learning in the many hours in the classrooms, but also through the duties they perform

here at the mission. Chores, work and maintenance projects, gardening, cooking, cleaning, washing, carpentry work, welding, animal husbandry and sewing are all part of the "lifestyle instruction" received by our Bible students. Most of our students come from areas of Mexico and families with very low financial income and would be unable to go to any seminary where tuition is required. God provides by grace and through you, our supporters, and enables us to give them room and board and also their training free of financial charge. This is a great blessing for God's on-going work here in Mexico! The last year of their training is of missionary service under the auspices of MITC, usually in one of our remote mountain regions where workers are needed to continue spreading the Gospel.

The other on campus Bible School program is our **Saturday Bible School**. This is for married and older students that are already heavily involved in ministry or family support and are unable to come daily to study here on campus. It is also a four-year program which covers most of the curriculum of the Full Time Bible School. The **2018-2019 School Year** has started and the Lord has given us 95 students in these two Bible School programs. They are training for the ministry in churches as missionaries, pastors, teachers, church workers, children ministers, etc. as there is a variety of ways the Lord uses our students and alumni in God's work here in Mexico. Please keep our staff and students in your prayers. We have one other program of Bible teaching called the **Local School Program**. These are extensions of our Saturday Bible School Program and are led by alumni certified by MITC and provided with all the necessary class materials to cover the first two years of the curriculum. Presently we have three extension seminaries, or Local Schools, and hope to open more in the near future.

They brought their drama team/kitchen crew/cleanup crew... to serve the campers. They brought graphic portrayals of man's need of salvation through superbly presented skits and with their service gave testimony of their love for Jesus. The other team, **Grace Baptist from Evans, GA** came for their second year in a row and was led by youth pastor **Bryan Carter** and by my own brother **Mark Hall**. It was great to have them here serving with the youth camp and helping us work on what will be a future outdoor basketball court/parking lot. They also helped work
